

Terms & conditions for use of Canoeing Ireland National Canoe Polo Committee (NCPC) boats

The following are terms and conditions to be issued to clubs who have the use of Canoe Polo Ireland boats.

1. NCPC boats on loan to clubs will be asset tagged and registered on Canoeing Ireland's asset file held in the Canoeing Ireland offices.
2. NCPC boats on loan to clubs should be in attendance at (a) a minimum of **one summer competitive event** (May-September) besides the Irish Open and (b) **the Irish Open**.
3. NCPC boats on loan to clubs should only be used on flat water and in swimming pools.
4. Clubs that have NCPC boats on loan should ensure that they are maintained to a standard suitable for competition paddling. Maintenance entails minor repairs. If however an NCPC boat on loan to a club is badly damaged (e.g. deep crack / hole in boat, etc), such damage should be reported to the NCPC. Where possible and if there is sufficient experience in the club, such damage should be repaired.
5. Secure storage (e.g., locked shed, etc) should be available for NCPC boats on loan to clubs onsite or nearby.
6. A fee of €50 p/boat p/6-month interval applies to each boat. This comprises a **refundable deposit of €30** and a **non-refundable rental fee of €20**. This is applied to raise revenue to ensure the sustainability of the development programme (i.e. the purchase of additional equipment for loan to clubs).
7. The borrowing club is responsible for repairing/ensuring the repair of any and all damage that occurs to the boats during the rental period. Likewise, the borrowing club is responsible for the loss or theft of any boat during this time.
8. During the course of the year, NCPC boats may be required for certain events (e.g. Paddlefest, TDU Ladies Development, etc.). In this instance, NCPC boats on loan to clubs should be made available for such events, and arrangements should be made by clubs holding NCPC boats to transport these to and from such events.
9. The NCPC reserves the right to reallocate boats to clubs and organisations in order to maximise the use of the boats to the canoeing community in Ireland.
